

# Bulls Eye!


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**Grades:** K-adult

**Subject:** Any Subject

**Group:** 2-20

**Materials:** white boards and markers for each student/group, suction ball, questions to ask, large wipe-off board with a bulls eye, 1 paper and pencil



## Procedure:

1. Buy a small suction ball. The small ones that come in a multi-pack as a party favor tend to work very well. Make a list of questions you want to ask, or use questions from a worksheet you won't have the students do.
2. Draw a bulls eye on a white board.
3. If you have 4 students or less, each student can play independently. If you have more than 4 students, separate the students into groups.
4. Pass out small wipe-off boards to each student/group. If you don't have them you can put a piece of plain white paper inside a plastic page protector. Students can use washable markers to write on the page protector, and can wipe it off with a wet wipe. Test this on one page protector first, since different page protectors and markers are made from different materials.
5. Ask everyone a question. Have students write the answer on the wipe-off board/page protector.
6. Check all answers. Each person/group with a correct response gets one turn to throw the suction ball at the bulls eye to earn points.
7. Record points earned and continue to play until time runs out. The person/group with the most points at the end wins.



## Modifications:


If you can't set up a bulls eye, just award 10 points for each correct answer.

When playing as a group:

- Make sure students take turns writing the answer on the white board.
- Make sure students take turns throwing the ball. Don't require students to throw the ball who have anxiety about their ability to throw. If they want to pass on their turn to throw, that is ok and doesn't affect their learning.

Who was the first man? (He lived in the Garden of Eden.)	Adam
Who was the first woman? (She lived in the Garden of Eden.)	Eve
Where did God tell Jonah to go?	Nineveh
Who built the ark?	Noah
What was the name of the giant David fought with a stone and sling?	Goliath
Who was Solomon's dad?	David
Who helped the widow's sick son?	Elijah
Who went up to heaven in a whirlwind with chariots and horses of fire?	Elijah

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Level 1 Questions	Answers
What did Elisha tell the widow and her sons to do to pay off her debt?	Pour her oil into all the jars she could borrow and sell it.
What happened when the men threw Jonah in the sea?	The storm stopped/a fish swallowed him
Whose mommy put him in a basket to keep him safe from pharaoh?	Moses
Who led God's people around the walls of Jericho and told them to shout?	Joshua
What did Elisha tell Naaman to do to be healed from leprosy?	Wash 7 times in the Jordan River
Who was the first king of God's people?	Saul
Who anointed Saul as king?	Samuel
Elijah challenged some prophets to see whose God would light their sacrifice on fire. Who was their false god?	Baal

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Level 2 Questions	Answers
On what day of creation did God make man?	Day 6
From what did God make woman?	A rib from Adam
How long was Noah on the ark?	About 370 days
What was the name of Goliath's army against which David fought?	Philistines
Where did Jonah try to go instead of Nineveh?	Tarshish
How did the men know that throwing Jonah in the sea would save them?	They cast lots and asked Jonah.
What was the pharaoh's decree from which baby Moses needed to be saved?	Hebrew boys to be thrown in the Nile; girls could live
Who was Solomon's mother?	Bathsheba

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Level 2 Questions	Answers
What did the widow and her sons do with the money left over after paying their debt?	They kept it
How long was Jonah in the belly of the big fish?	3 days and 3 nights
Who found baby Moses in the basket in the Nile River?	Pharaoh's daughter
How many times did the Israelites walk around the walls of Jericho on the last day?	Seven times
Who told Naaman about Elisha?	A Hebrew servant girl
Why did the Israelites have Saul as king?	They wanted a king like the other nations had.
What warning did God give the Israelites about having a king?	It wouldn't be good. They should follow Him.
What did Elijah do to his sacrifice that would have made it even harder for God to light it on fire?	Covered it in lots of water
