































<div>Plane Shape Dominoes</div> <div>©2004 Education Inspired</div>	<div>Groups of 2-4 Grades 3-5</div> <div>How to Play</div> <div><div>1. Remove the title, instruction cards, and answer key.</div><div>2. Deal 5 domino cards to each player. Lay the extra cards face down to make a draw pile.</div><div>3. The first player to the left of the dealer who has a double, meaning both words on the card have the same shape, plays the double to start the game. If no player has a double, reshuffle and start over.</div><div>4. Continuing around the group, players match ends of the cards by placing words with the same shape together. Cards can be played on either end or either side of a double.</div><div>5. If a player cannot play in turn, one card must be taken from the draw pile. The card drawn can be played if it is a match. Once the draw pile is empty, no more cards must be drawn if a player cannot play.</div><div>6. The first player to play all of his or her cards wins the game. The answer key may be used when a play is questioned.</div><div>7.
