# Fruit Basket 

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For grades 1+; Groups of 2-4

## Materials Needed:

Fruit Basket game board
Game pieces (such as erasers or plastic finger puppets)
Fruit pieces
Brown construction paper
1 die

## How to Construct:

1. Laminate the game board onto the front of a manila envelope, and the rules on the back of the envelope. Make sure the envelope is open when it is laminated.
2. Laminate the fruit.
3. Cut out the pieces. There are 4 sets of fruit (one for each player).
4. Use scissors to slice open the laminate at the opening of the envelope.
5. Store the game pieces in the game board envelope.
6. Cut brown construction paper to look like a basket. (Optional - allow children to cut out and decorate their own baskets before playing the game)

## How to Play:

1. Each player places a game piece anywhere desired on the game board.
2. In turn, roll a die and move the number of spaces shown.
3. Identify the fruit of the spirit landed on. For advanced players, also say the definition of the fruit of the spirit or give an example of it. If the answer is correct, take the piece of fruit that you landed on if you do not have it, put it on your basket, and your turn is over. If your answer is correct and you already have the piece your turn is over. If the answer is incorrect, you do not get the piece. If you already have it and the answer is incorrect, you must put it back on the game board. (Optional - allow beginning players to keep earned pieces, even if they later give an incorrect response).
4. The first player to fill his or her basket with one piece of each fruit (9 pieces) wins.
*Remember that the fruit pictures and pieces are just for fun, and they don't actually have anything to do with fruits of the Spirit.
