



Fun at the Fair





"I do not like this!" Tess yelled.


"Just shut your eyes, Tess," yelled Jim.

"Does it cost very much?"


"No," said Dad. "It costs one dollar. Do you have one

"I must stand very still. I will look at the bottles when I toss the ring," said Jim.


Jim picked up a ring. He looked at the bottles and tossed the ring.

the box. But the rest of the cans were still on top of the box. The man stacked the tin cans.


Jim picked up the next ball.

Jim looked at the ball in his hand.


Then the ball went very, very fast. It hit the cans.





"Look!" yelled Jim. "I did it. I did it."
