**Grades:** K-adult

**Subject:** Fruit of the Spirit

**Group:** 3-6

**Materials**: Boards for each student, square covers for each student, set of cards for each group, pencils



#### Procedure:

- 1. Make copies of the game board, one for each student, and get bingo covers or cut squares of paper.
- \*If you do not want to use the words in the word box, there is a blank template at the end of this file.
- 2. Check the question cards to be sure you understand them. Make your own new cards to match the way you have studied the fruit of the Spirit if you need/want to.
- 3. Cut out the question cards.
- 4. Put the game in a center to play. (Make sure students know how to play the game before asking them to play it independently.)





#### **Modifications:**


**English Language Learners**: Allow students to make the question cards for you by putting synonyms from their native language on the cards for them to match the English words.

**Struggling Students:** Help them write the words from the word box onto the board and review their meanings while writing. For students who need additional help, allow them to work with a partner.
