

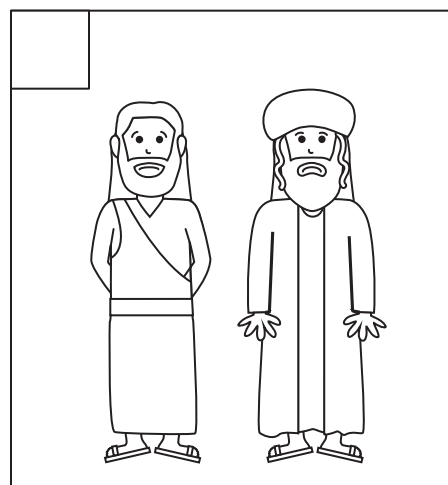
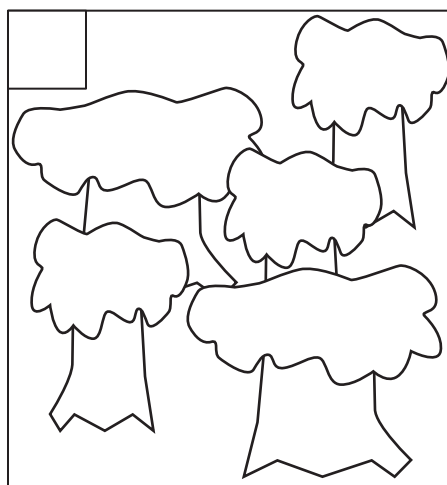
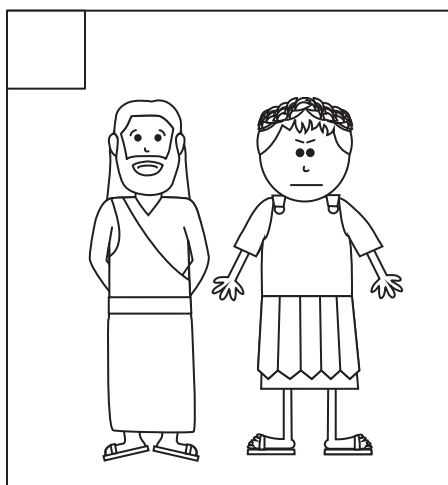
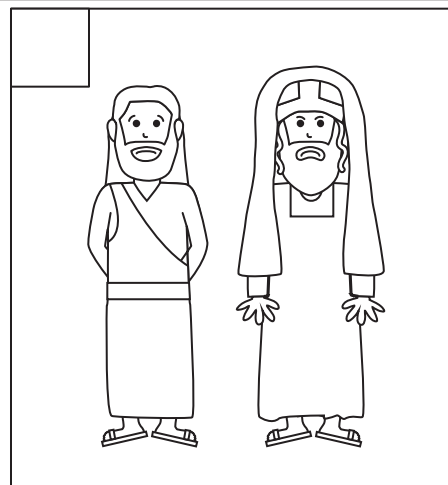
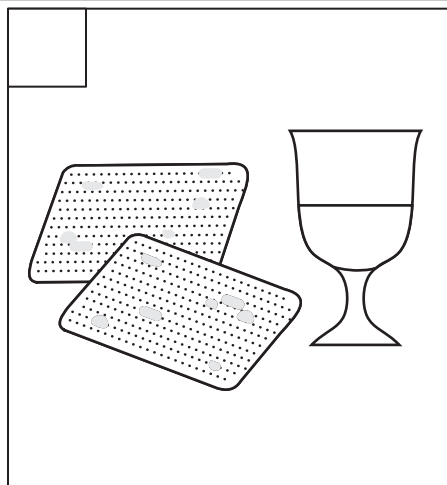
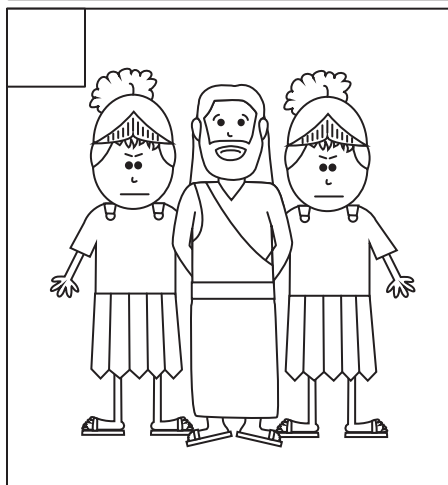
# Order Up!
