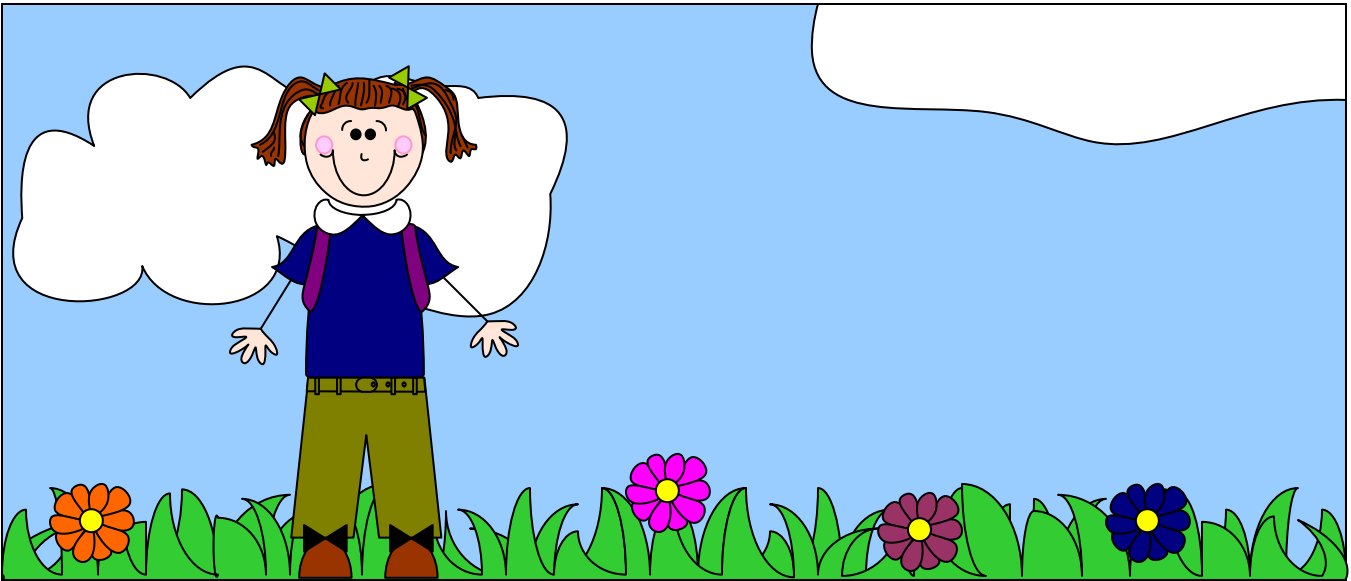

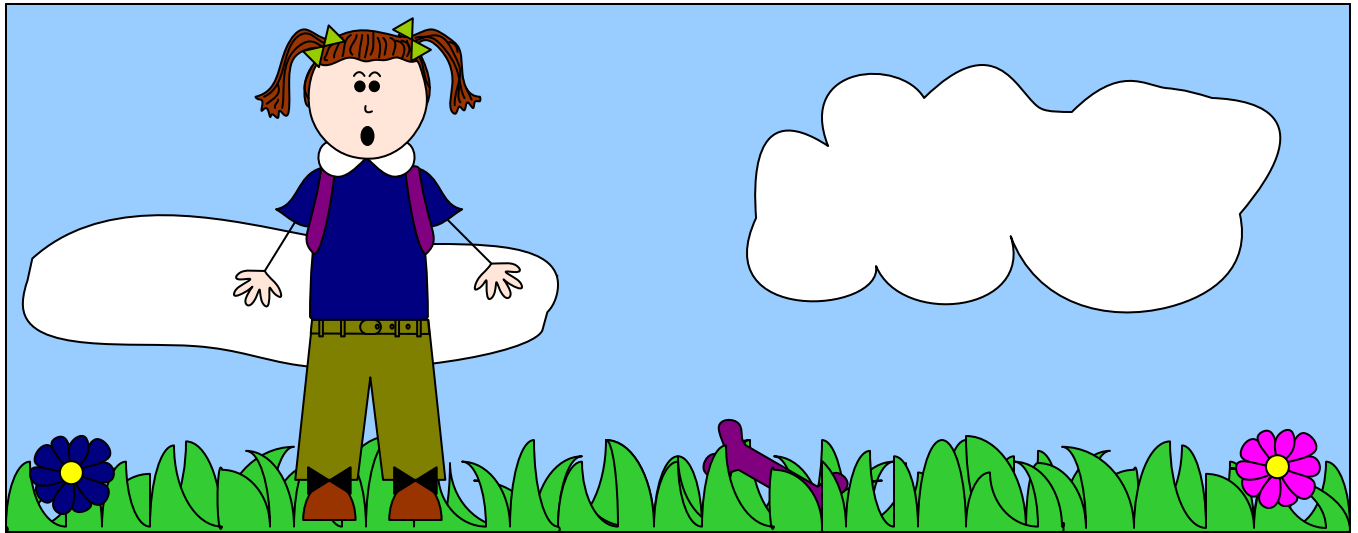

One day, when Kim was on a walk in the grass on the way home, she saw something. What was it? Kim did not know. Maybe it was a treasure.



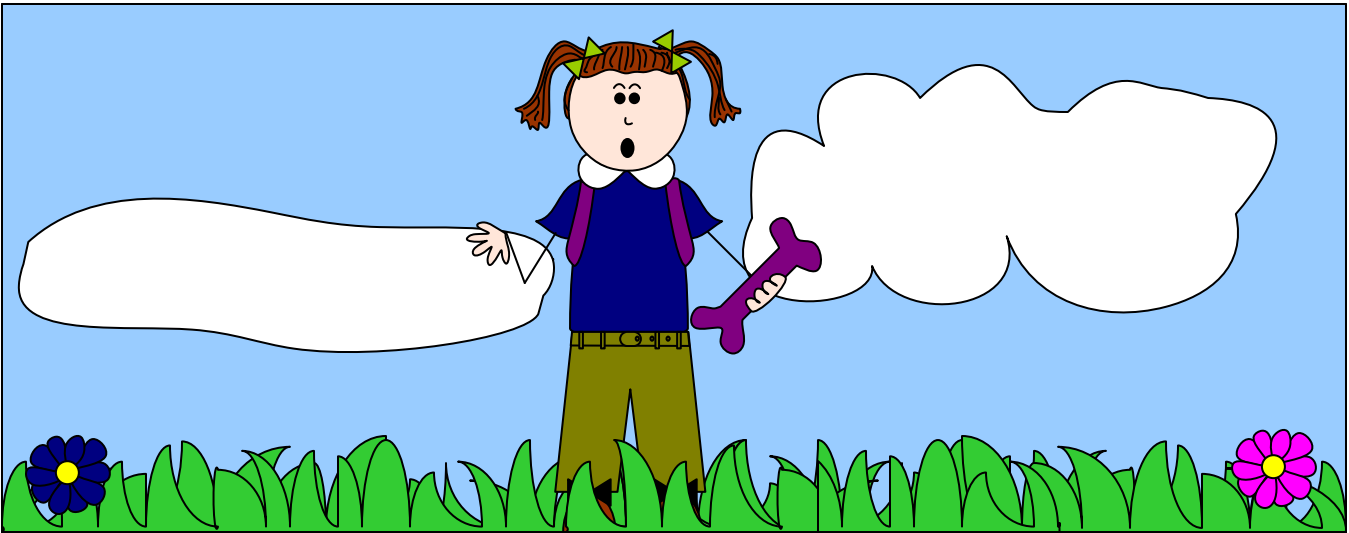

Kim did not know what to do with the bone. She put the bone in her treasure bag and ran home to tell her mom about it.

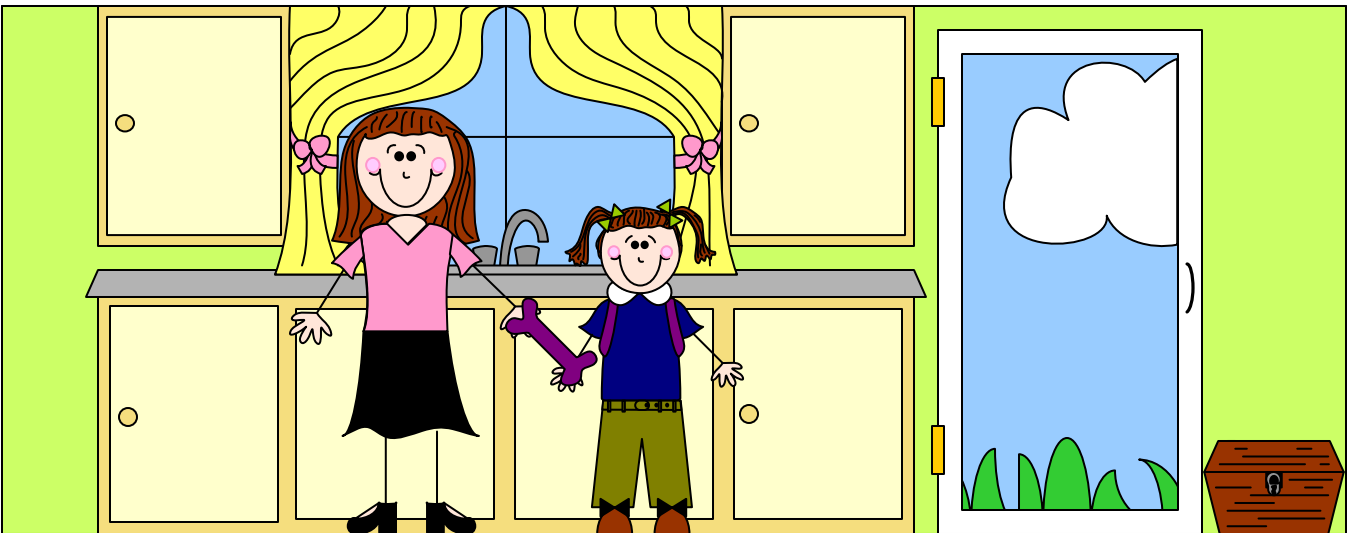

Kim pulled the bone out of her bag and gave it to her mom.

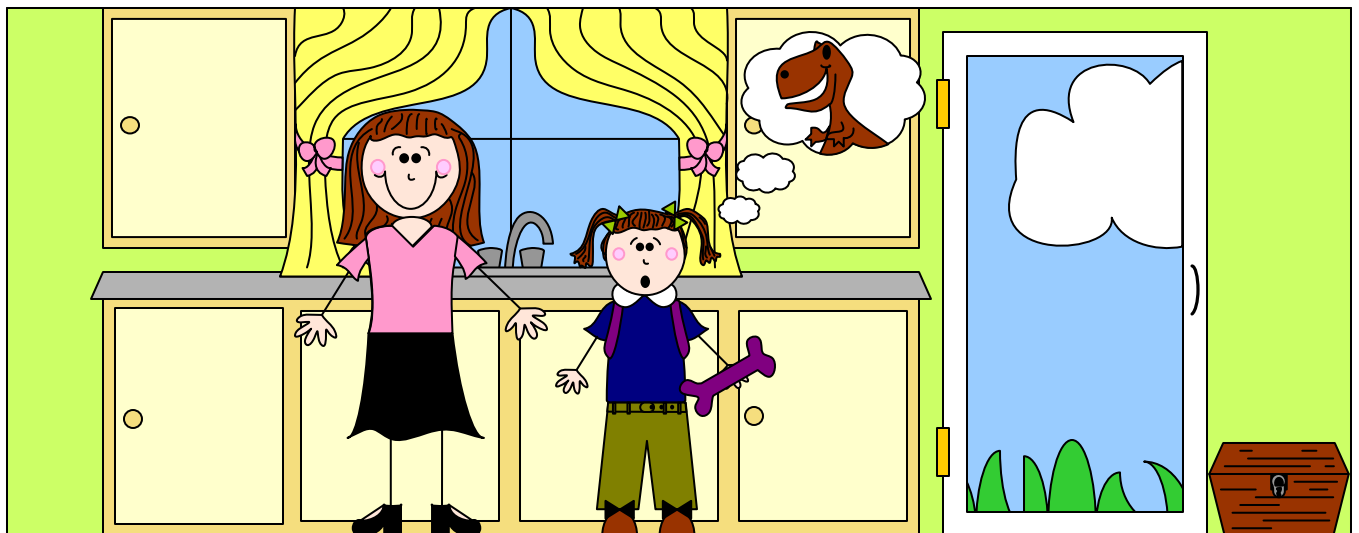

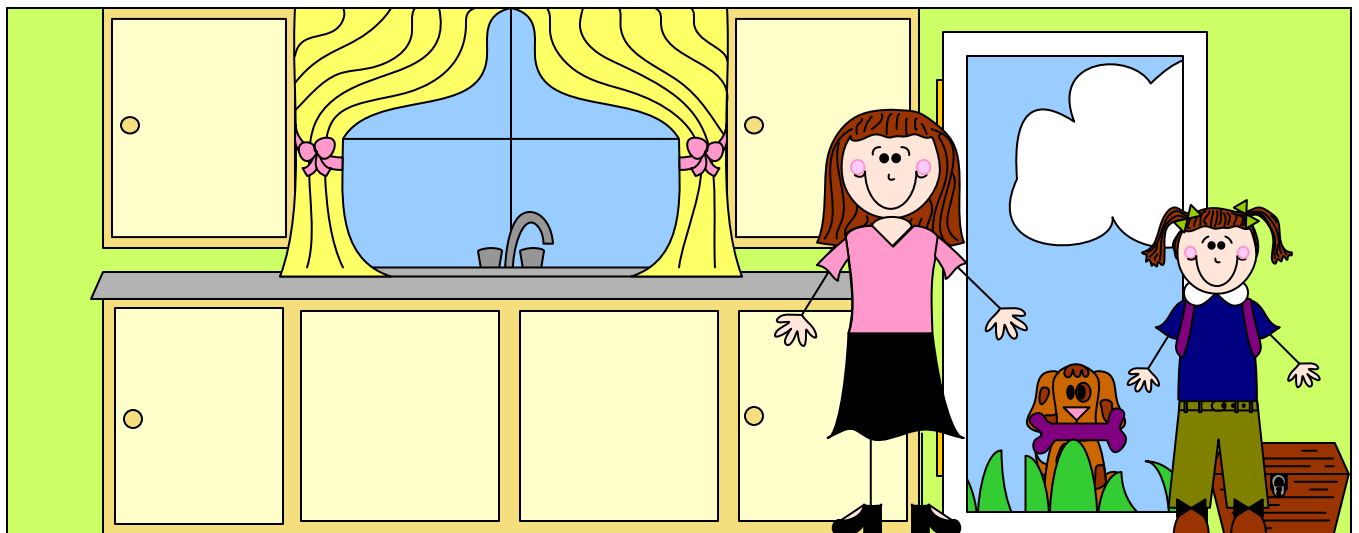
“Oh!” said Kim. “Maybe the bone was for the dog! Mom!

think the dog wants her bone back!”

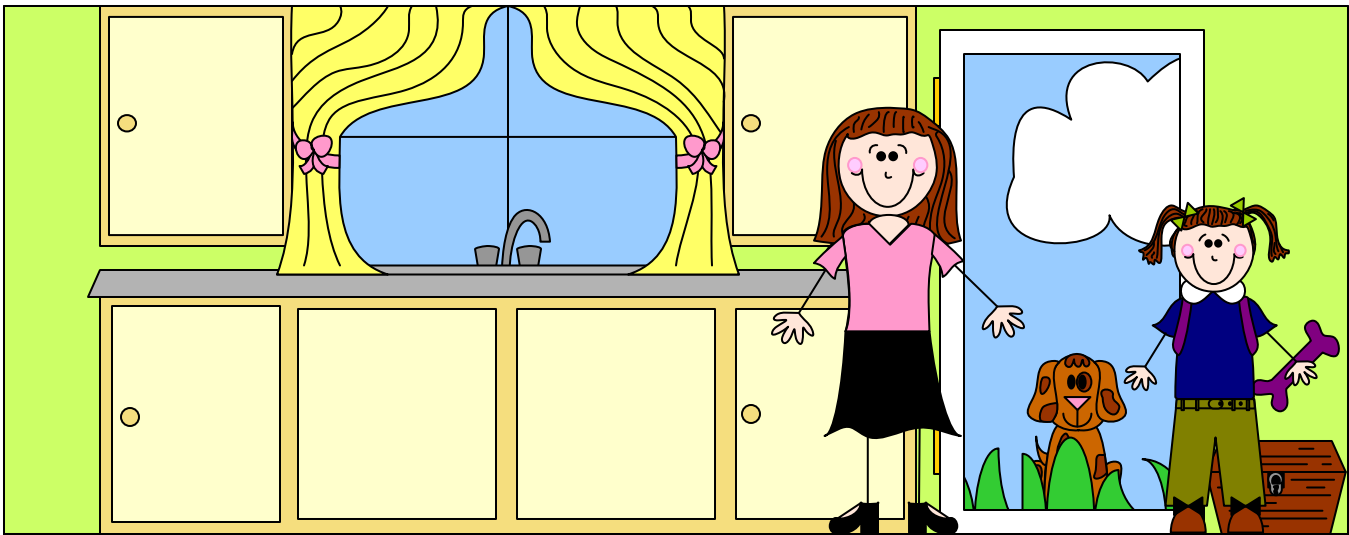

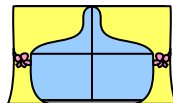
