


## Lazarus Lives

Lazarus had died and went to him. When Jesus got there,




Lazarus had already been in the tomb for four days.

friends had come to Martha and Mary to tell them how






sad they were about Lazarus.

that he will rise again in the resurrection on the last day."




Jesus said, "I am the resurrection and the life. Anyone who


Then Martha went away to talk to her sister Mary. She secretly said to her, "The Teacher is here and is calling for

Jesus had not gotten to the town yet, but was still in the place where Martha met Him. When the friends saw Mary get up quickly and go out of the house, they followed her.


They thought she was going to the tomb to cry.


