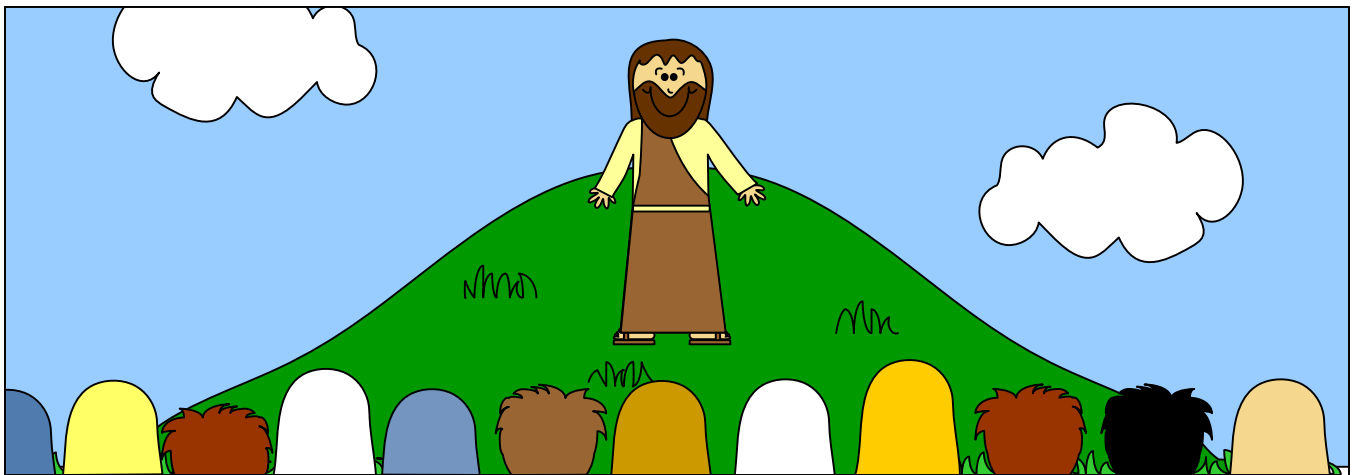


The Parable of the Lost Son

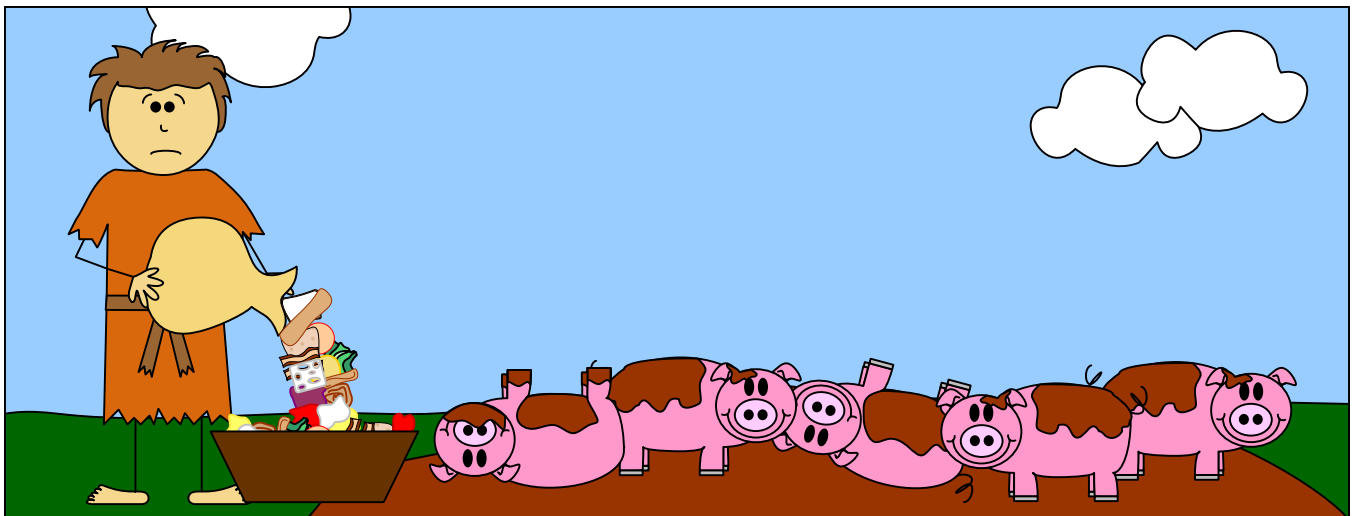
There was a man who had two sons. The younger son asked his dad to give him his share of the family's property. The dad gave his sons their shares.

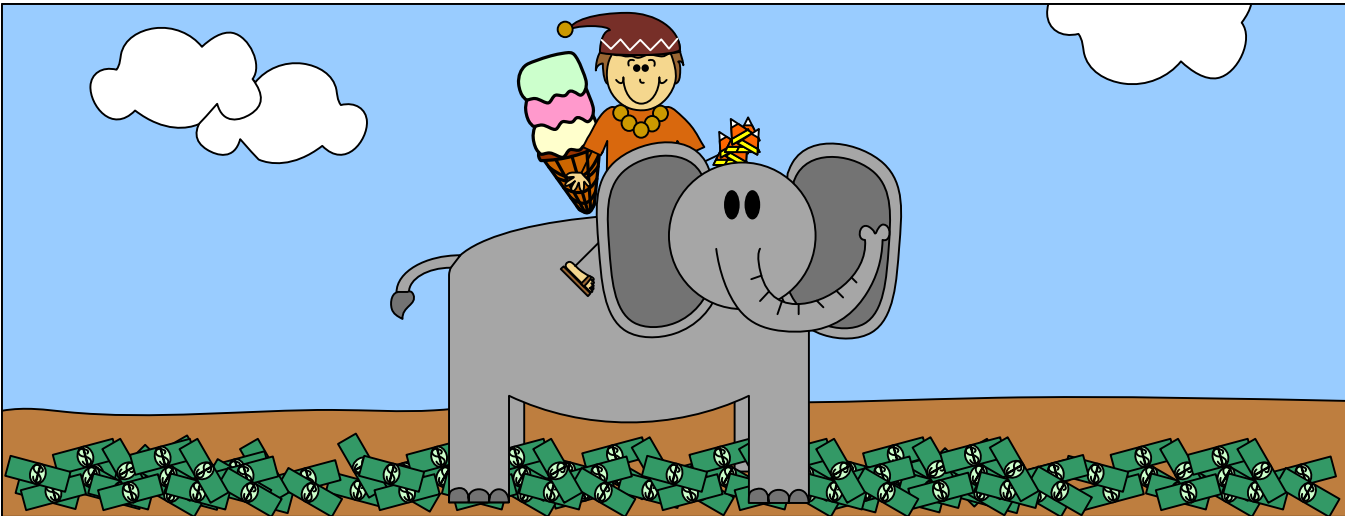
Soon, the younger son got all his things and left home.

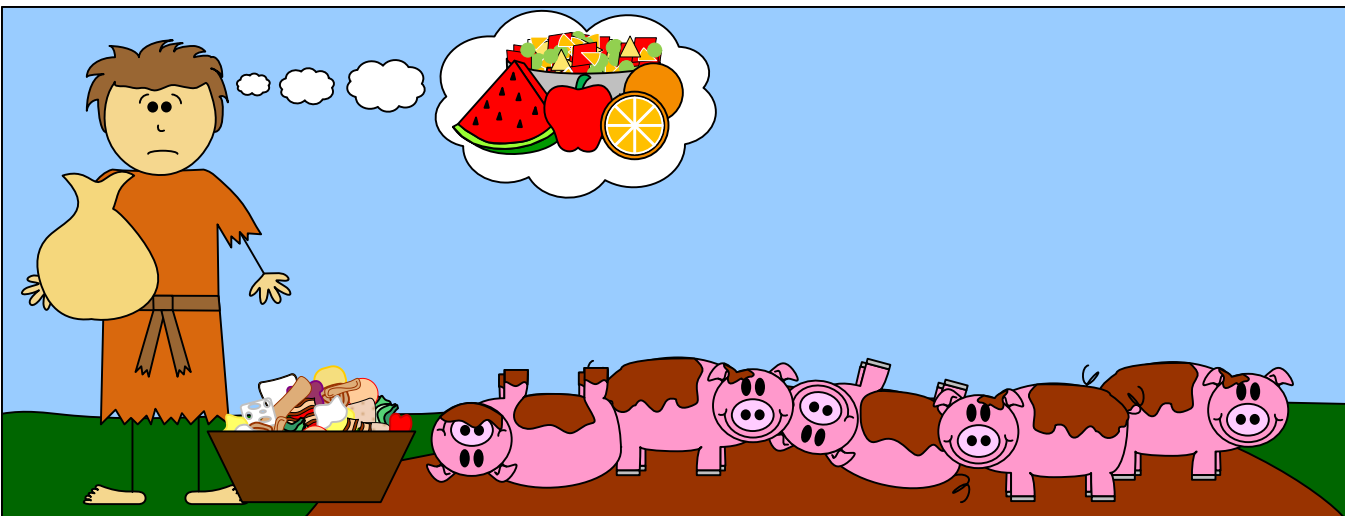


He went to a man and got a job feeding the man's pigs. He was so hungry that he wished he could eat the pigs' food. No one gave him anything.

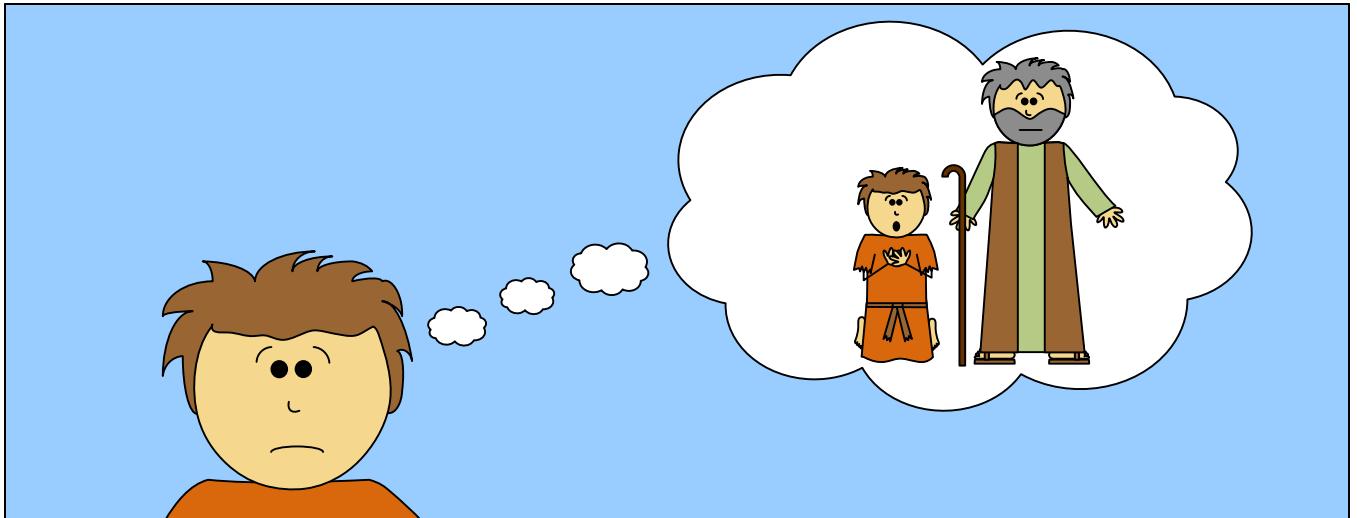

He went far away and spent all his money on things that  were not important and on living a wild life. When all his money was gone, there was not much food in the land,  and the son was in need.

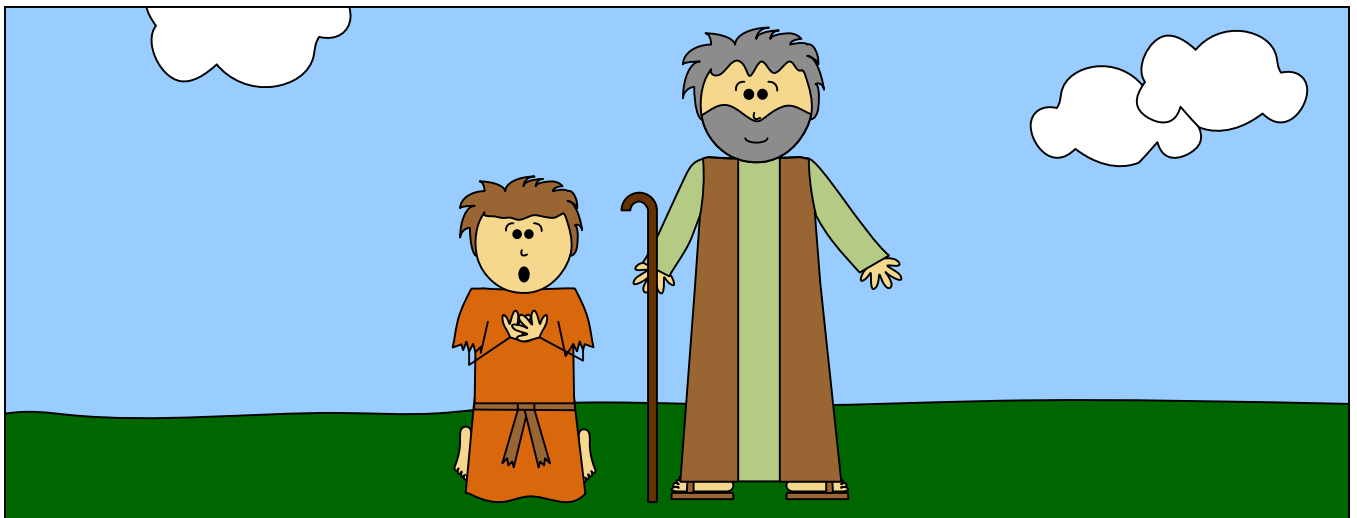


The son started thinking. He remembered that the workers at his dad's house always had extra food. Why should he be so hungry when his dad's workers had extra food?



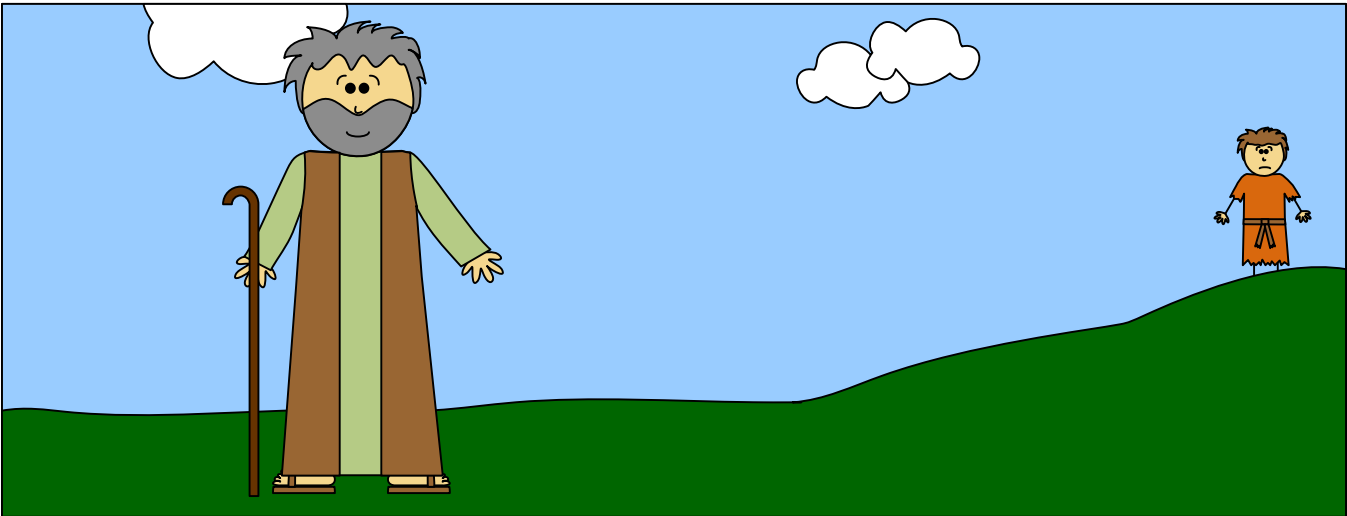

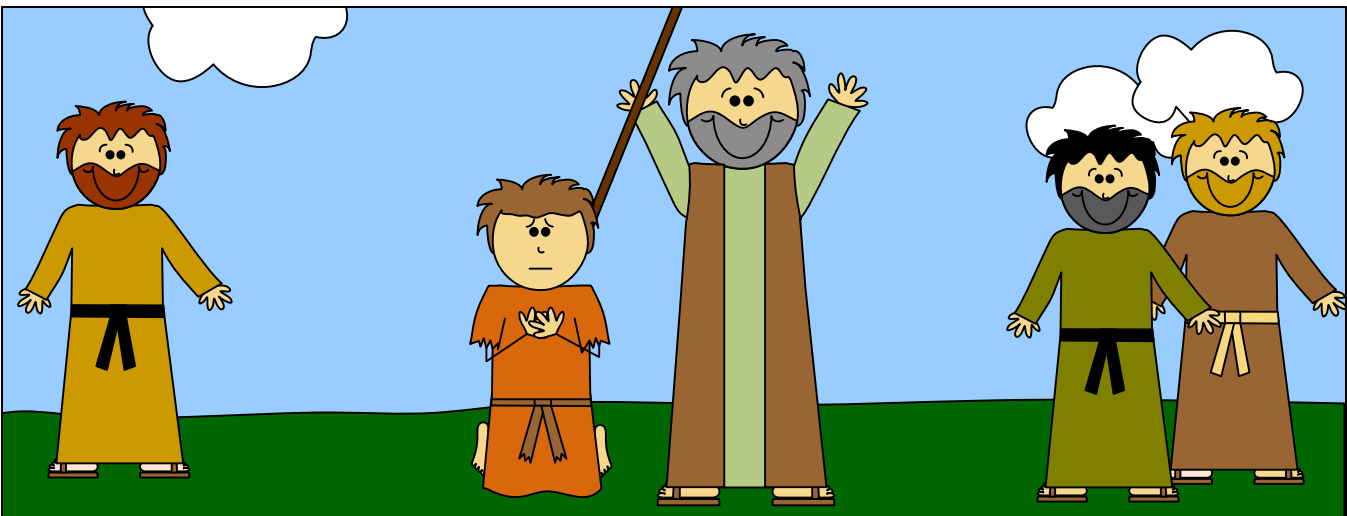
The son said to his dad, "Dad, I have sinned. I have done so many bad things. I shouldn't be called your son anymore."

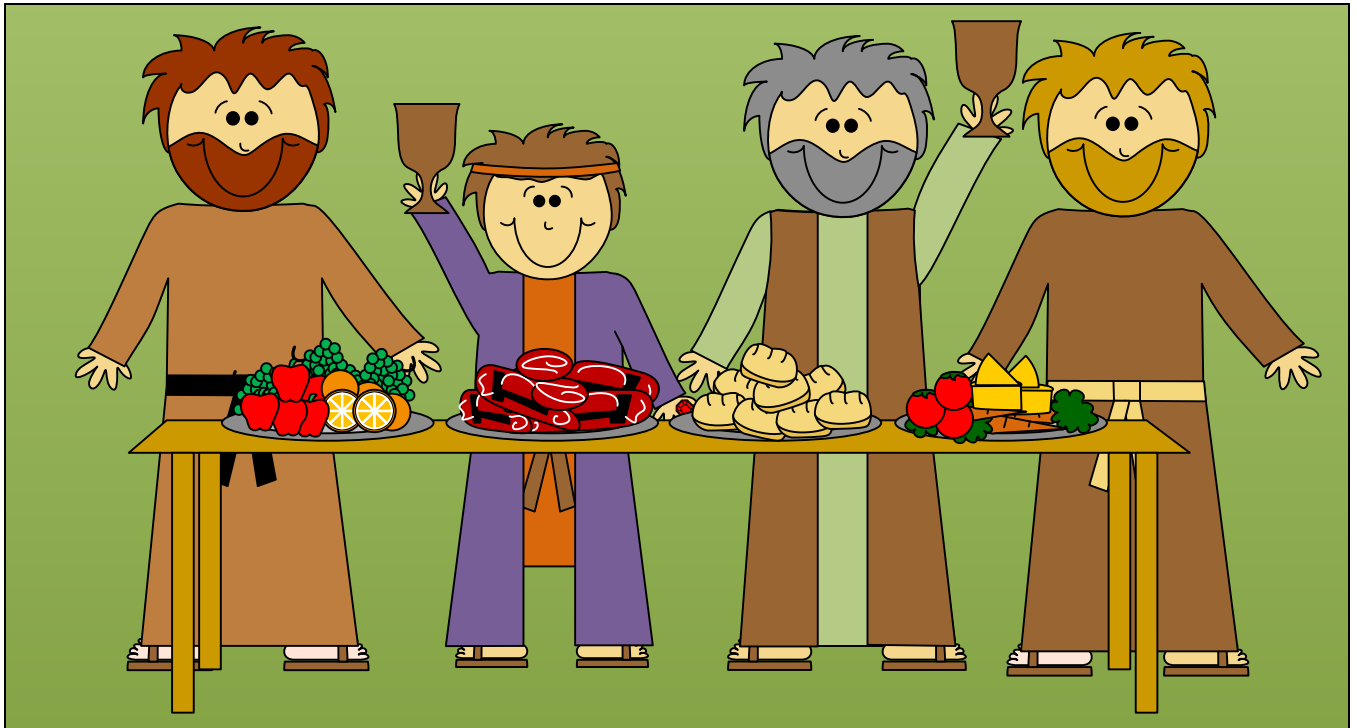
While he was still a long way away, his dad saw him coming. He was filled with love and grace for his son. He ran to his son and hugged and kissed him.

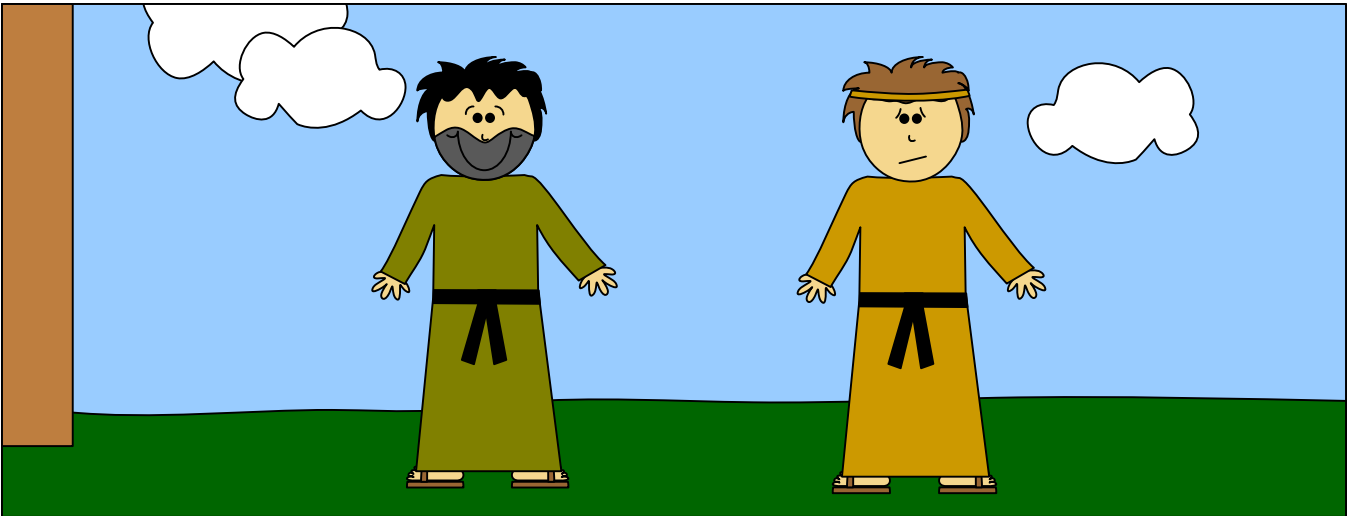
So they had a great party.

The older brother got very mad and would not go to the party. His dad went out to try to get him to go to the party.

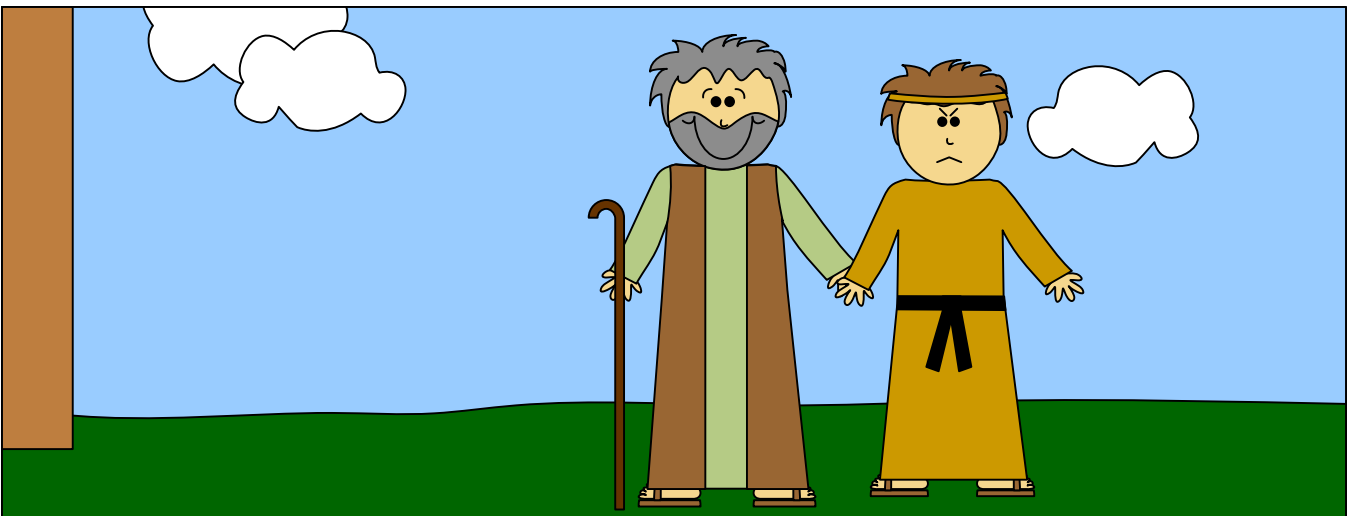
