

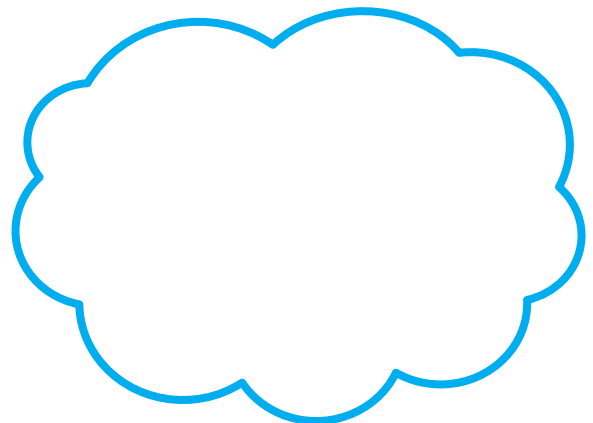
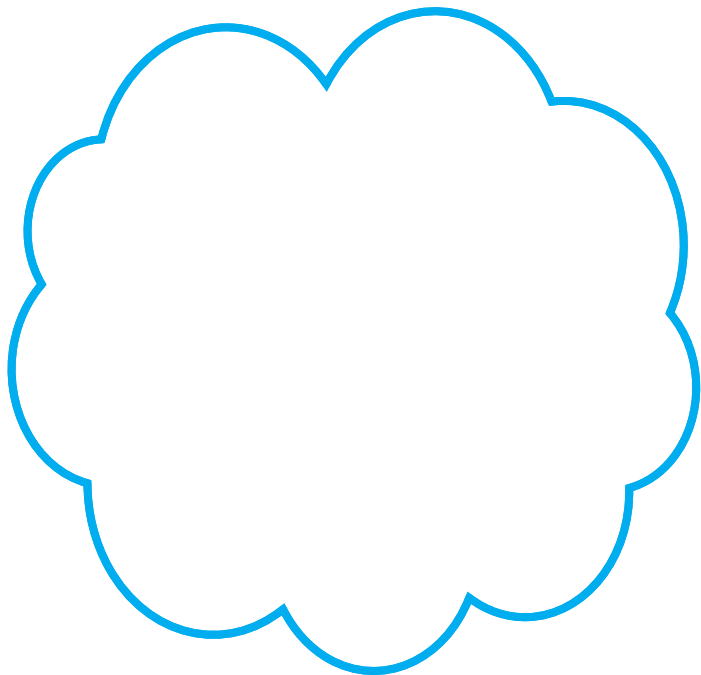
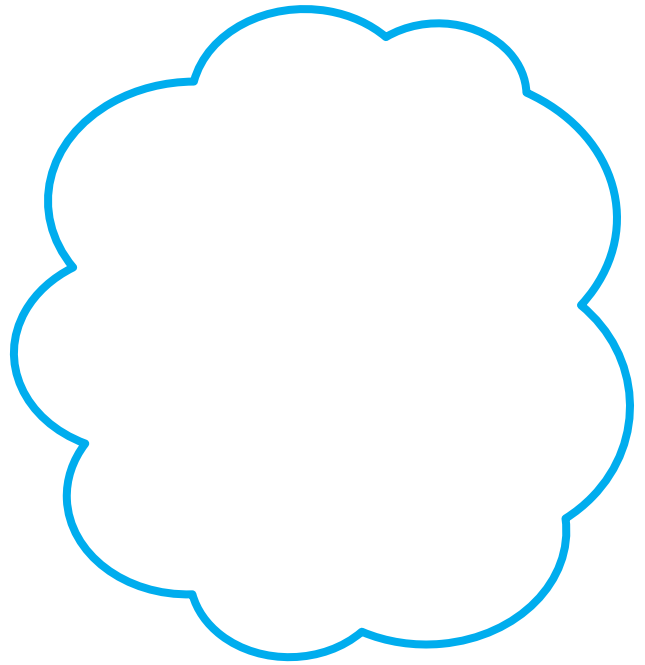
Imagine That!
