

Multiple-Meaning Word Map

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Purpose: To understand multiple meanings of one word





Materials: blank paper, pencils





Procedure:

- Pass out one piece of paper to each student.
- Students write the vocabulary word in the middle of the paper and draw a circle around it.
- Students write the various definitions of the word near the word. Draw a circle around each definition, and then draw a line from each definition bubble to the center bubble.
- Students write a sentence as an example of each definition near each definition bubble. Draw a circle around each sentence, and then draw a line from the sentence bubble to the corresponding definition bubble.
- Optional: Students can add another bubble with an illustration of each definition. Draw a line from the illustration bubble to the definition bubble.
