


The jailer was told to watch Paul and Silas carefully. So he put them in a spot in the middle of the jail. He put locks on their feet so they could not get away.





About midnight, Paul and Silas were praying and singing songs to God. The other people locked in the jail were listening to them.



Everyone's chains came loose.



The jailer woke up and saw the doors open. He thought all the men in the jail had gotten away. He got his sword and was going to kill himself with it.




The jailer got some lights in the jail so he could see.




But Paul shouted, "Don't harm yourself! We are all here!"


He rushed over to Paul and Silas. He fell on the ground
