

Slap It

Even and Odd

For grades 1-3, Groups of 2-4

How to Play:

1. Take out the rules, answer key and cover card from the deck. Separate the cards by color.
2. Shuffle each set of cards and place them face down in two stacks.
3. Take turns turning over the top cards in each stack and place them side by side face up.
4. If the cards match, the first person to slap in the middle of the cards wins all the cards in the piles. For example, if the cards show "63" and "odd," they match and should be slapped.

Answer Key

Even	Odd
1	2
3	4
5	6
7	8
10	9

Play continues until all the cards have been turned over.

5. If the cards slapped are not a match, the player who slapped the cards must give the other players each one card.
6. The player with the most cards at the end of the game wins.
