1 die

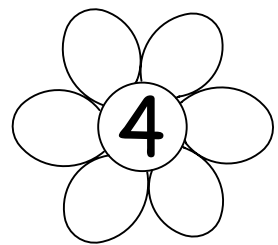
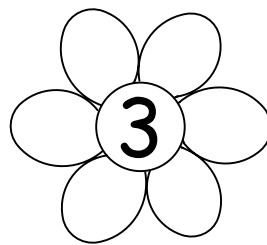
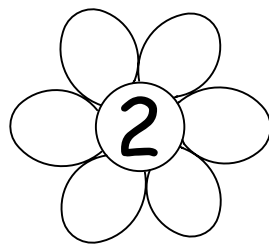
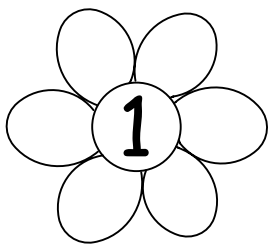
How to Construct:

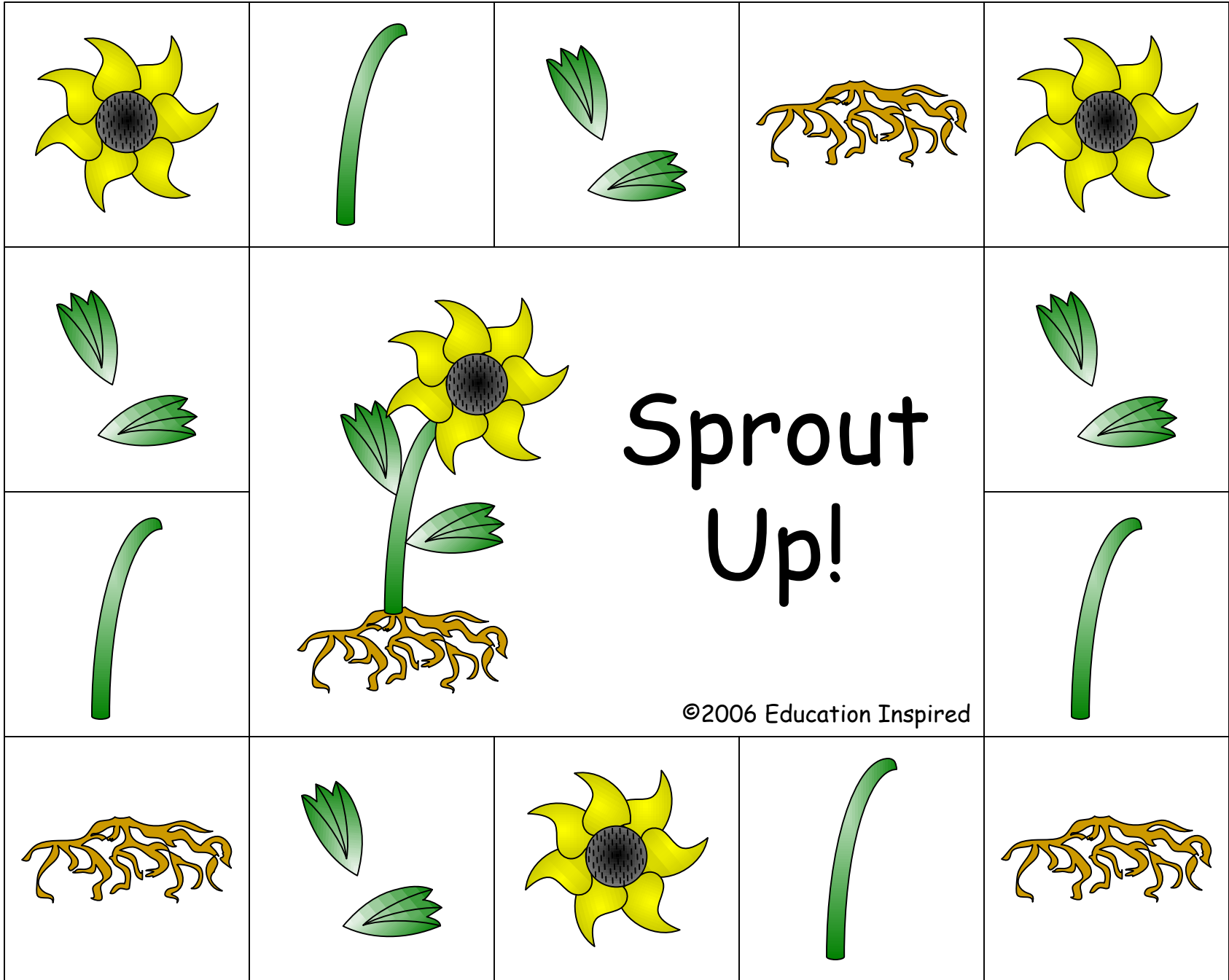
1. Laminate the game board onto the front of a manila envelope, and the rules on the back of the envelope. Make sure the envelope is open when it is laminated.
3. Laminate the game pieces and flower parts.
4. Cut out the pieces. There are 8 sets of flowers.
5. Use scissors to slice open the laminate at the opening of the envelope.
6. Store the game pieces in the game board envelope.

How to Play:

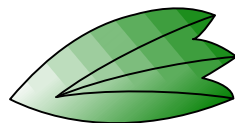
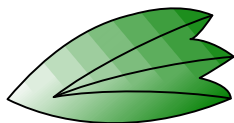
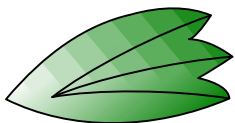
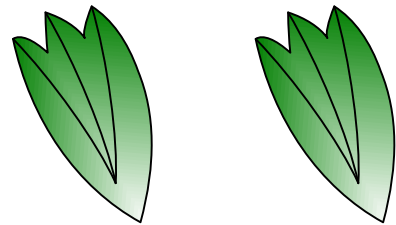
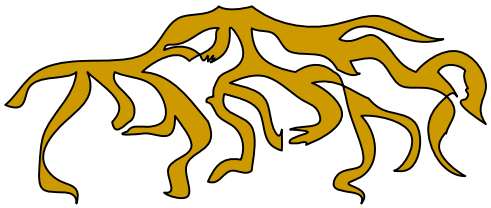
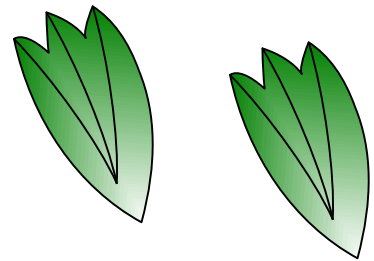
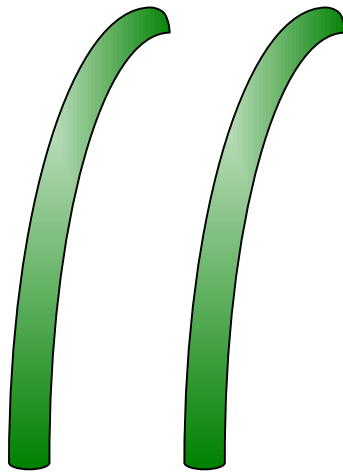
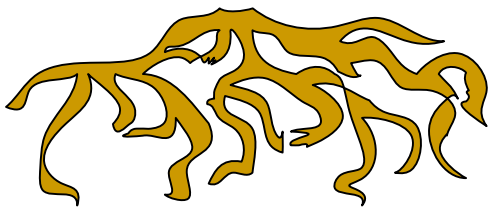
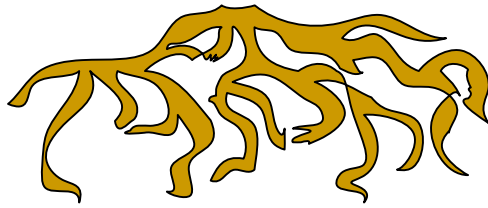
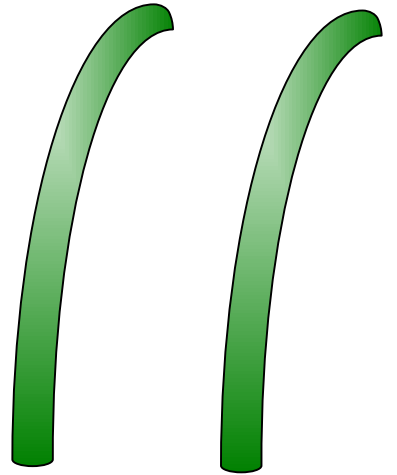
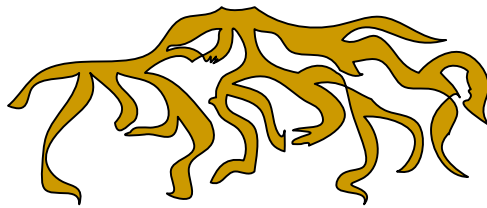
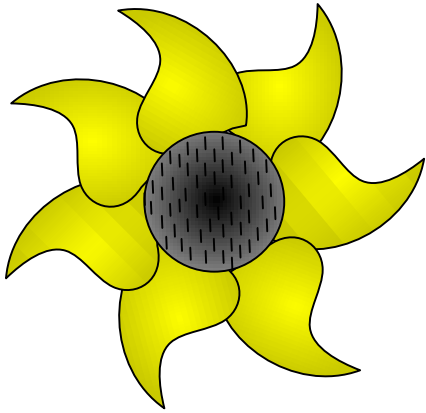
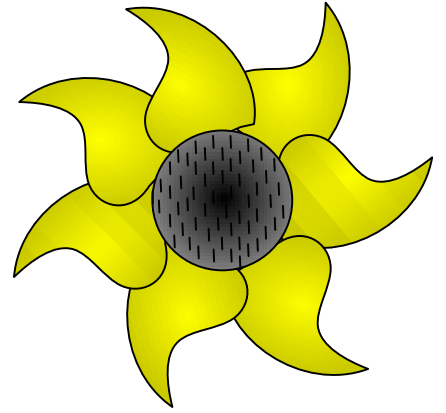
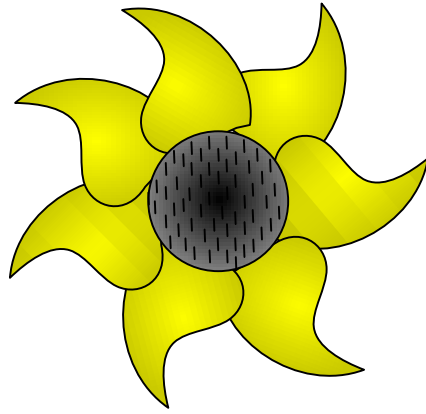
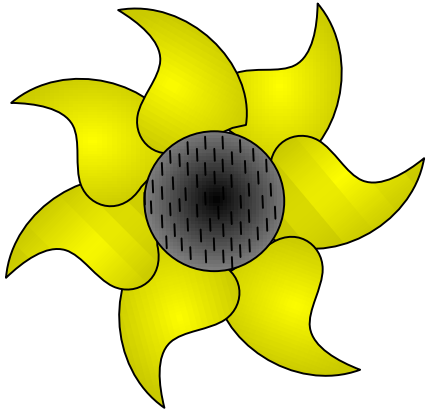
1. Each player places a game piece anywhere desired on the game board.
2. In turn, roll a die and move the number of spaces shown.
3. Identify the plant part landed on and its function for a plant. If the answer is correct, take the piece of plant that you landed on if you do not have it and your turn is over. If your answer is correct and you already have the piece your turn is over. If the answer is incorrect, you do not get the piece. If you already have it and the answer is incorrect, you must put it back on the game board.
4. The first player to collect two complete flowers wins.
