# Tow the Line 

## Synonyms and Antonyms

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Groups of 6+, Grades 2-4
How to Play:
Divide the class into two groups. Group one stands in a line, facing the facilitator, a few steps away from group two, which should also stand in a line facing the facilitator. The first two people in each line play at one time. Hold up a card and have the students identify if the words are synonyms or antonyms. The first person to respond correctly wins the round and stays at the front of the line. The other player goes to the end of the line. Players try to stay at the front of the line as long as possible. Team points can be kept if desired.
