

Sam likes to play ball. Sam is up at bat. He likes to





Bam! Sam hits the ball.






"Hit the ball, Sam!" said Tom. "You can do it. You can hit the ball."






"I see it," said Tom. "I see the ball up in the tree."

"I did it," said Sam. "I hit the ball!"




"Look at that ball go!" said Jack.




Where will it go? Where will it land?
