- King Nebuchadnezzar ordered Ashpenaz to train young Israelite men from royal families to serve in the palace. Daniel, Shadrach, Meshach, and Adednego were among those picked.
- Daniel asked the chief official if he and his friends could eat vegetables and drink water instead of the king's food so that they would not break God's law.
- The chief official was afraid that he would get into trouble if he agreed. Daniel asked the guard assigned to them if they could try it for 10 days, and the guard said yes.
- Daniel and his friends were stronger and healthier than the others at the end of the IO days. God honored Daniel and his friends because they chose to follow His laws.

- An angel appeared to Daniel in a vision and said, "Do not be afraid. You are a man treasured by God. From the first day you humbled yourself, God, heard your prayers."

- Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego refused to bow to the statue. They told the king that God could rescue them from the furnace, but even if He did not, they would not bow to the statue.
- Nebuchadnezzar became angry and had the 3 men tied up and thrown in the furnace. When he saw 4 men walking around in the furnace instead of 3, he was amazed.
- The king called for them to come out of the fire. All 3 came out completely unharmed.
- Nebuchadnezzar recognized that God had rescued them because they had refused to worship any other god.

### King Darius gave Daniel a very important job. The other leaders became jealous. They tried to get Daniel in trouble, but Daniel had done nothing wrong.
