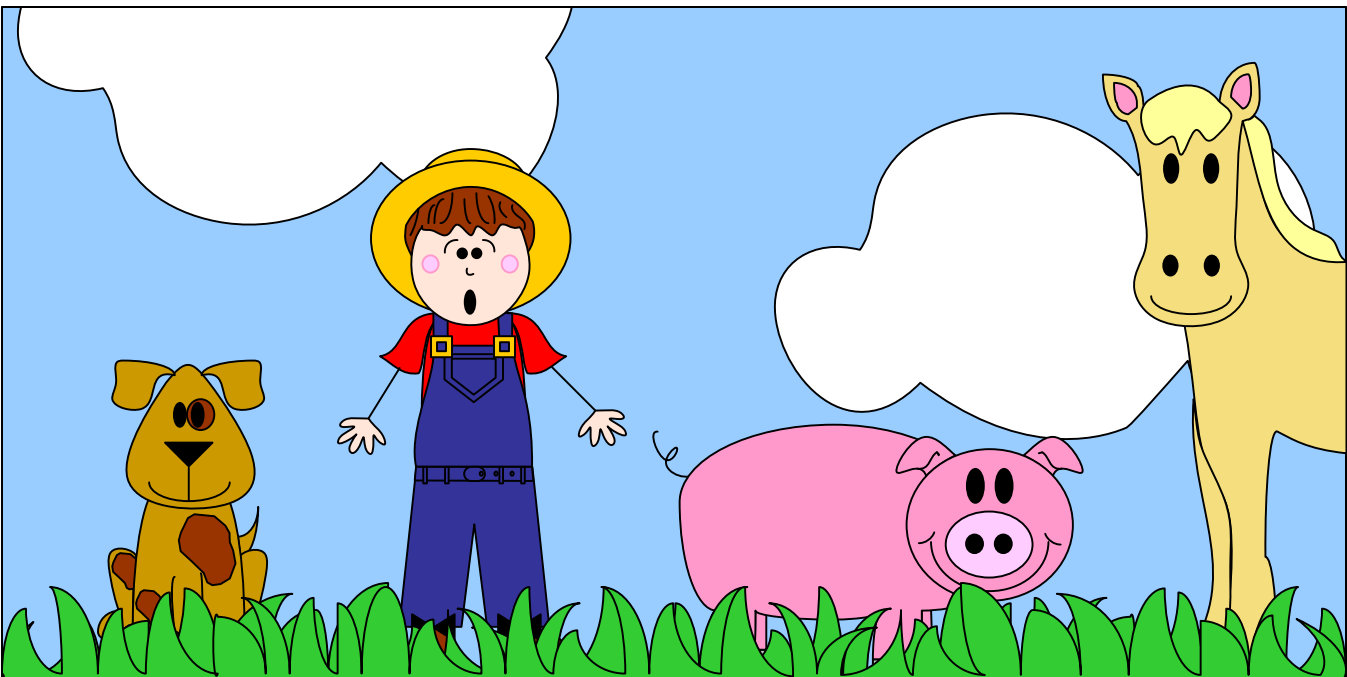


The farmers did not know what to do to stop all the noise and calm down the animals. The farmers ran from animal to animal trying to catch them and calm them down.



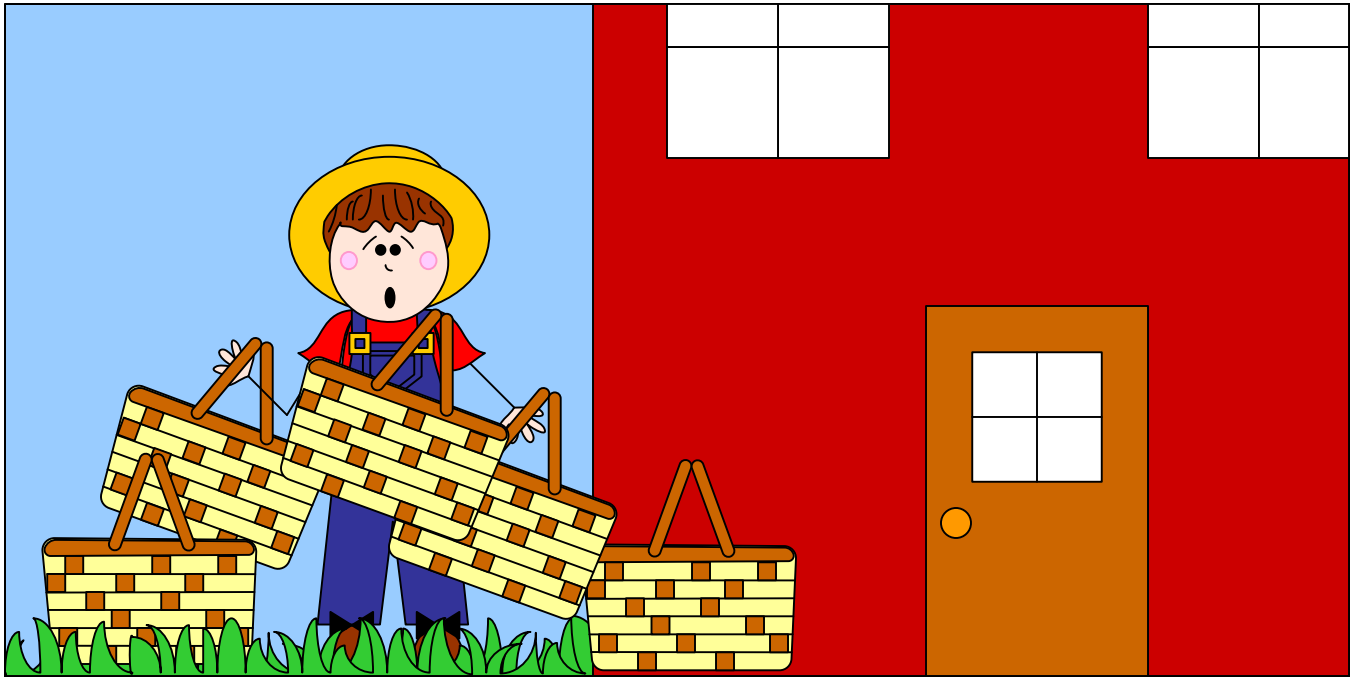
It was very loud on the farm with all the animals running

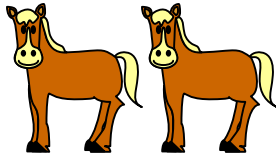

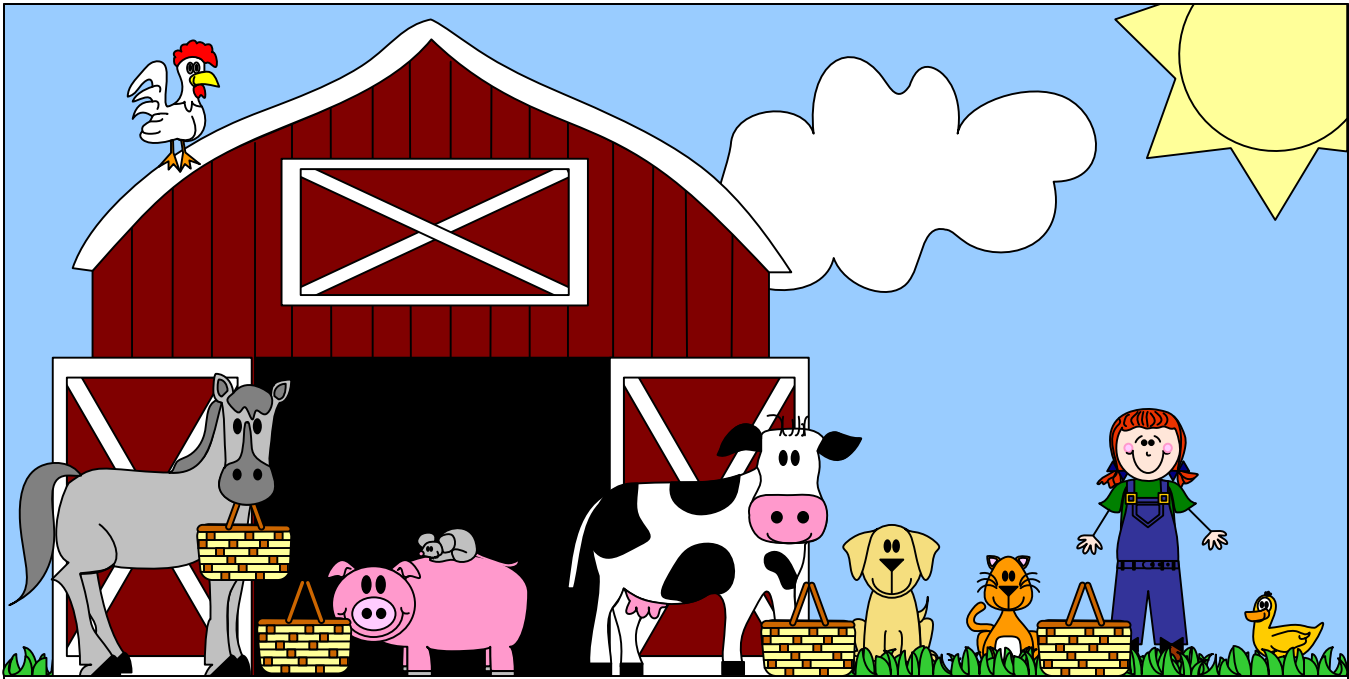
